PUBLIC NOTICE

Notice #15089-1 December 30, 2024

This notice is to inform the public that the S.C. Department of Environmental Services (SCDES) is taking public comments on a Corrective Action Plan (CAP). This CAP addresses the cleanup of soil and groundwater contamination at the facility listed below. The contamination was caused by petroleum products that were released from underground storage tank system at this facility. Based on current data, chemicals of concern are below Site Specific Target Levels. SCDES intends to monitor the contamination to determine if natural attenuation is occurring.

FACILITY: 7 Eleven #36840, 3301 Wade Hampton Blvd, Taylors, SC

APPLICANT: Crown Central LLC, 100 Light St, 25th Floor, Baltimore, MD

SUMMARY OF CAP:

Petroleum and petroleum byproducts naturally break down over time through chemical, physical, and biological processes. These processes are called natural attenuation. Periodic monitoring will be conducted by SCDES to ensure that the contamination has decreased and remains below levels of concern.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD DEADLINE: The **deadline** for submitting written comments is **5 PM January 24, 2025.** Any interested person(s) may submit written comments concerning the cleanup to the Project Manager listed below. Please bring this notice to the attention of persons whom you know will be interested in this matter. Where there is a significant degree of public interest, SCDES will hold a public meeting.
