NOTICE OF 30-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD
Ashley Landing Shopping Center
Charleston, South Carolina

SCDES (the South Carolina Department of Environmental Services) is accepting public comments on a proposed Voluntary Cleanup Contract through February 12, 2025.

The First Amendment to Voluntary Cleanup Contract 24-7844-NRP will affect approximately 3.071 acres located at 14 Sumar Street, Charleston, South Carolina. The property is further identified by Charleston County tax map serial numbers 352-08-00-006 and the Sumar Street Abandonment. A company known as Ashley Landing (Edens), LLC (Edens), wants to acquire the property and intends to develop the property for mixed use.

A gas station formerly operated on the property. The past use of the property may have caused environmental pollution on the property.

SCDES uses Voluntary Cleanup Contracts to encourage productive reuse of Brownfield sites. If this Voluntary Cleanup Contract is implemented, SCDES will allow Edens to acquire the property as a "Brownfields Site" because of the potential for environmental pollution from past activity on the property.

SCDES will not hold Edens responsible for pre-existing pollution in exchange for doing work under the Voluntary Cleanup Contract. Under the proposed contract, Edens will test soil and groundwater on the property. If significant contamination is found, Edens will be required to take steps to protect human health and the environment. Edens did not create the pollution, but will control it to keep the property safe for re-use. Under State law, Edens will not be responsible if anyone has been affected by the contamination. The responsibility of former owners or operators of the property is not reduced by this contract.
