This notice is to inform the public that the S.C. Department of Environmental Services (SCDES) is taking public comments on a Corrective Action Plan (CAP). This CAP addresses the cleanup of soil and groundwater contamination at the facility listed below. The contamination was caused by petroleum products that were released from underground storage tank system at this facility.

## **SUMMARY OF CAP:**

Petroleum and petroleum byproducts naturally break down over time through chemical, physical, and biological processes. These processes are called natural attenuation. EnviroSouth Environmental Consultants has submitted a CAP proposing the use of the following technology(ies) in addition to natural attenuation to clean up the contamination.

**Surfactant Injection:** Surfactant is injected to increase the mobility of the petroleum contamination.

**PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD DEADLINE:** The **deadline** for submitting written comments is **5 PM July 24**, **2025.** Any interested person(s) may submit written comments concerning the cleanup to the Project Manager listed below. Please bring this notice to the attention of persons whom you know will be interested in this matter. Where there is a significant degree of public interest, SCDES will hold a public meeting.
